Now that you have done that, I would like to tell you a little story. One day I was on my way to work. I was feeling stressed and really lacking energy. I really wanted to stop by a store and pick up my favorite drinks for the day. I immediately felt guilty at the cost. Then I heard the Lord remind me that I had a \$10 bill in my purse. I thought about it and dismissed the idea as excessive. How could God want me to waste that money? Then I heard Him say in that still small voice, "That is what it's for." I started crying right then that God would care about me wanting a drink. I realized that I had fallen into a trap of believing that God didn't want to bless and take care of me. So I headed into the store and bought my drinks. Then as the woman handed the money back to me.

I heard, "And the rest is for her." So I gave her the money so she could get a drink too. By then it was not even \$4. You would think that I had handed her a \$100 bill. She was so shocked and so clearly blessed that I began to rethink all I knew about how God really wants to work in my life and the lives of those around me.

What if all of this time, I was trying to be responsible and missing opportunities? It goes so much further than a \$10 bill in my pocket. God began to show me all of the things that He has given me that I didn't even realize could be used for His purposes. He even began to show me spiritual gifts that I had overlooked as strangeness or even dismissed as bad vibes.

It was around this time, that the idea to write it down came to me at 3am. Never underestimate those 3am ideas. It's in those moments that the noise of the cares of this world falls away and we can really focus on the faith that can move mountains. You were made to move mountains.

WHAT IT'S FOR

Envisioning What It's For.

An important part this view is to know that God can turn everything that happens in our life for our good and that He wants to. This idea began to bloom in my mind after hearing a sermon on the open hand. Often as Christians, people see us with a closed fist. We grab onto the gifts, money, or talents that God gifts us with and we hold on as tight as we can. In fact, Sundays are often the worst day to work in food service where tipping is the norm because Christians are notorious for not tipping or tipping less than other people. What this pastor said about this really began to play over and over in my mind. He said that if we keep our hands open then God can continue to put more in. Instead of worrying about lack, we can open ourselves up for more to share with the world around us.

This is true of more than just money. It can be energy, talents, stuff, time, and community. Even revelations from God can be like this. I can remember when I started noticing major accounts reposting my comments as their main posts. I was shocked and then I worried a bit. I prayed, "But God, now when I say those things people will think that I am just parroting someone else." You know what He said? "That's ok, they weren't your ideas anyway. I'll give you more." Mic drop.

It's important to remember that God also wants to bless you. As you become a partner in the kingdom of God, it's important to remember that you are a loved son or daughter. Some of the money, stuff, community, etc. that you are holding right now lightly in your hands is God's loving gift to you, just because you are His delight.

As I journey through this life, I have been so blessed by knowing "what it's for." This is true for me with extra time, money, communities, even influence or skills. Sometimes the Holy Spirit just wants to me to feel the love of the Father wash over my heart, but other times I find the things in my hands right now are actually to be a part of making the world around me a better place.

One day, I asked the Lord for ways that I could bless my community. I felt like he was leading me to tip \$5 whenever I went to the gas station. I live in Oregon and gas attendants still pump your gas here. Gas was over \$5 per gallon and this felt a little hard at the time, but I am working on fast obedience so I did it. When I told another Christian about this, I was told I had to tell them about God whenever I did it. I quickly noticed that this made the people feel irritated. When I asked God about it, He told me that He just wants people to be blessed. I didn't need to force anything. So I went back to just showing gratitude and tipping.

I began to notice that the gas attendants stayed near my car while my gas was pumping so I was able to talk to them a little. I usually just asked about their day. One day, I noticed one man was having a bad day. I told him that I would pray that God would turn that situation completely around to him getting a raise. He laughed and said that he was going to hell so not to bother. I was able to share all about the love of God that day. When I left, he was smiling and I knew this is "what it was for."

Are there any ways, that you can bless your family or community that God is bringing to mind right now? Even the smallest things can make a big difference. God delights in our smiles and our joy. Even as you attempt to bless the people around you, you will notice that blessings are contagious. You cannot bless people without getting blessed right back. I know because I keep trying. When I bring flowers to businesses, I have to bring them after I pay or else they try to give me free food.



What Are Your Passions?

Delight yourself in the LORD; And He will give you the desires of your heart.

Psalm 37:4.
